INTERNSHIP OPPORTUNITIES

OUTREACH & EDUCATION SERVICES

AFG's Outreach Program helps teens and women engaged in high-risk activities, such as street-based prostitution, drug use, and gang involvement, understand the risks and transition to safe choices and healthy lives.

CRISIS RESOURCE CENTER INTERN (3)

Crisis Resource Center provides services for walk-in clients. Any member of the community in crisis may walk in to discuss their needs in private. Assist with determining whether the person is eligible for AFG services and/or make referrals to other organizations based on that person's needs.

Hours: Daily, 9:00 AM to 9:00 PM (4-hour shifts)

SAFE CHOICES PROJECT INTERN (1)

Safe Choices reaches out to girls and women involved in sex work to provide them with harm reduction tools. New Choices, a component of Safe Choices, works with girls and women who want to exit sex trafficking and provides them with the skills they need to lead fulfilling lives.

Hours: Monday and Tuesday, 11:00 AM to 3:00 PM & Wednesday and Thursday, 6:00 to 10:00 PM

PEER EDUCATION INTERN (1)

Peer Education is a youth leadership program that trains at-risk youth to reach out to other at-risk youth in the community. The teams focus on topics such as healthy relationships, HIV, homelessness, internet bullying, and making positive choices.

Hours: Tuesday thru Thursday, 5:00 to 8:00 PM

PREVENTION

AFG's Outreach Program helps teens and women engaged in high-risk activities, such as street-based Finding self-esteem, improving a grade-point average, rejecting drugs and alcohol, pregnancy prevention, connecting with a mentor, discovering untapped talents — these are some of the experiences girls have when they take part in AFG's Prevention Program. These experiences can happen in a summer (through the Rise-N-Shine program), during the course of a school year (through after-school workshops and mentoring), through our Asset Building college preparation and access program, or across the span of several years as girls mature from 10 to 19 years of age, building their character on a foundation of positive choices.

AFTER-SCHOOL PROGRAM INTERN (3)

During academic school year, only.

Hours: Tuesdays, Wednesdays, and Thursdays, 1:00 to 7:00 PM

RISE N' SHINE INTERN (3)

During summer, only.

Hours: Tuesdays and Wednesdays 9:00 AM to 3:00 PM and Thursdays 9:00 AM to 4:00 PM

ASSET BUILDING INTERN (1)

Hours vary

SHELTER

AFG's Shelter Program provides a stable home, counseling, and life skills training to homeless young women aged 15-21 and their children. The goal is to empower them to lead productive and fulfilling lives. AFG's Shelter can house up to 30 young women and their children. In addition to providing homeless young women with a safe and stable place to stay, AFG also provides life skills classes, counseling and case planning services to those we serve—all with the goal of giving them the tools they need to lead fulfilling and independent lives.

CASE PLANNING INTERN (2)

Hours: Monday thru Friday, 9:00 AM to 7:00 PM

VOLUNTEER SERVICES INTERN (1)

The Volunteer Services Intern will assist with the processing of new volunteer and interns, volunteer database management, planning of volunteer events, and community engagement.

Hours: Mondays thru Friday, 10:00 AM to 4:00 PM
