



# WHAT WE DO

In 1987, Alternatives For Girls (AFG) began as a community effort to support girls and young women in southwest Detroit. Today, our mission remains the same, and the need for our services has grown. Three decades later, we continue to broaden and deepen our programming with the goal of making permanent change in individuals' lives.

Just this past year, we have helped over 3,000 girls and young women in Detroit and our surrounding communities live safer and healthier lives. We rely on strong community support to help our most vulnerable girls and young women who are at-risk of or experiencing homelessness, being trafficked, or abused.
